



Joseph Sr. and Lucy Mack Smith Scholarship

Eligibility Rules and Application Information

Scholarship Theme: How learning about Joseph Sr. and Lucy Mack Smith's family's values and sacrifices can help me and my family honor their legacy.

Eligibility:

Available to all Jr. high and high school and college students who are or will be attending higher education to receive a college or equivalent degree or certificate. Students must submit a short letter of recommendation from their local youth leader to ensure they are a person of good standing and have a history of service to their community. Lineal descendancy from Joseph Sr. and Lucy Mack Smith is not required.

Scholarship Grand Prize: \$1000

2nd Place: \$500

3rd Place: \$250

Jr. Scholarship Award \$250

(available only to Jr. High students)

Application Deadline: July 1, 2018

Scholarships will be announced at the annual Smith Family Reunion (Salt Lake City, August 4, 2018).

Application Requirements:

The student must provide the following:

- Completed Application Form (see below)
- Recommendation letter from the student's local youth leader, including an affirmation of the student's past service/contribution to the community.
 - The youth leader can be an ecclesiastical leader or adviser, school counselor, scout leader, etc.
- Submit one of the following items which incorporates the Scholarship Theme:
 - Video portraying an aspect of the Smith Family's life and its relevance to you
 - Videos can be made with iPhone, Android, camcorder, etc., and uploaded to the Joseph Sr and Lucy Mack Smith webpage at: <http://josephsmithsr.org/scholarship/>
 - Essay or poem (No more than 4 type written pages, double spaced, Arial 11pt font)
 - students who submit essays and poems must also submit a video of themselves or a family member reading the essay or poem.

Important: By filling out and signing the Application Form, the student recognizes and accepts that all submissions will be shared via the Joseph Smith Sr. and Lucy Mack Smith Facebook page, website, Instagram and Twitter accounts. Videos should be fun to watch and engaging. Points will be given for videos with the most likes.

The scholarship award will be given to the parent or guardian, who will acknowledge that they will use the money for the intended purpose and college.

Additional Resources

The following books may be helpful in learning about the Smith Sr. family: History of Joseph Smith by his mother Lucy Mack Smith, Joseph Smith's New England Heritage, by Richard Lloyd Anderson. Submission preparation and uploading Instructions

When you are ready to submit your video and/or essay, artwork, etc., please follow these instructions:

Video:

- The maximum length for videos is 5 minutes.
- Make sure video has an introduction, where you state your name, age, school and college/institution you plan on attending. Speak clearly and slowly, and after you state your name, please spell it out.
- At the end of your video, take a moment to state why you want to honor Joseph Sr and Lucy Mack Smith's family, what they mean to you, and what Smith values you are incorporating into your life.
- Save your video with your first and last name in the file name, so we can identify it with your work.

- Send your Scholarship application to the following email address: scholarship@josephsmithsr.org

Essay/poetry:

- Make sure your essay has an introduction, with your name, age, school and college/institution you plan on attending.
- Include in your essay why you want to honor Joseph Sr and Lucy Mack Smith's family, what they mean to you, and what Smith values you are incorporating into your life.
- Make sure you also video yourself or a family member reading your essay/poem.
- Send your Scholarship application and essay to the following email address: scholarship@josephsmithsr.org

Artwork:

- Take a picture of your artwork. Make sure the image is high enough resolution, so the judges can see the detail (at least 1 MB, but no more than 5 MB).
- Save the image in jpeg format and include your first and last name in the file name.
- Include a short video explaining why you wanted to do the artwork, what it represents, and how it helps you or those who view it, honor Joseph Sr and Lucy Mack Smith's family.
