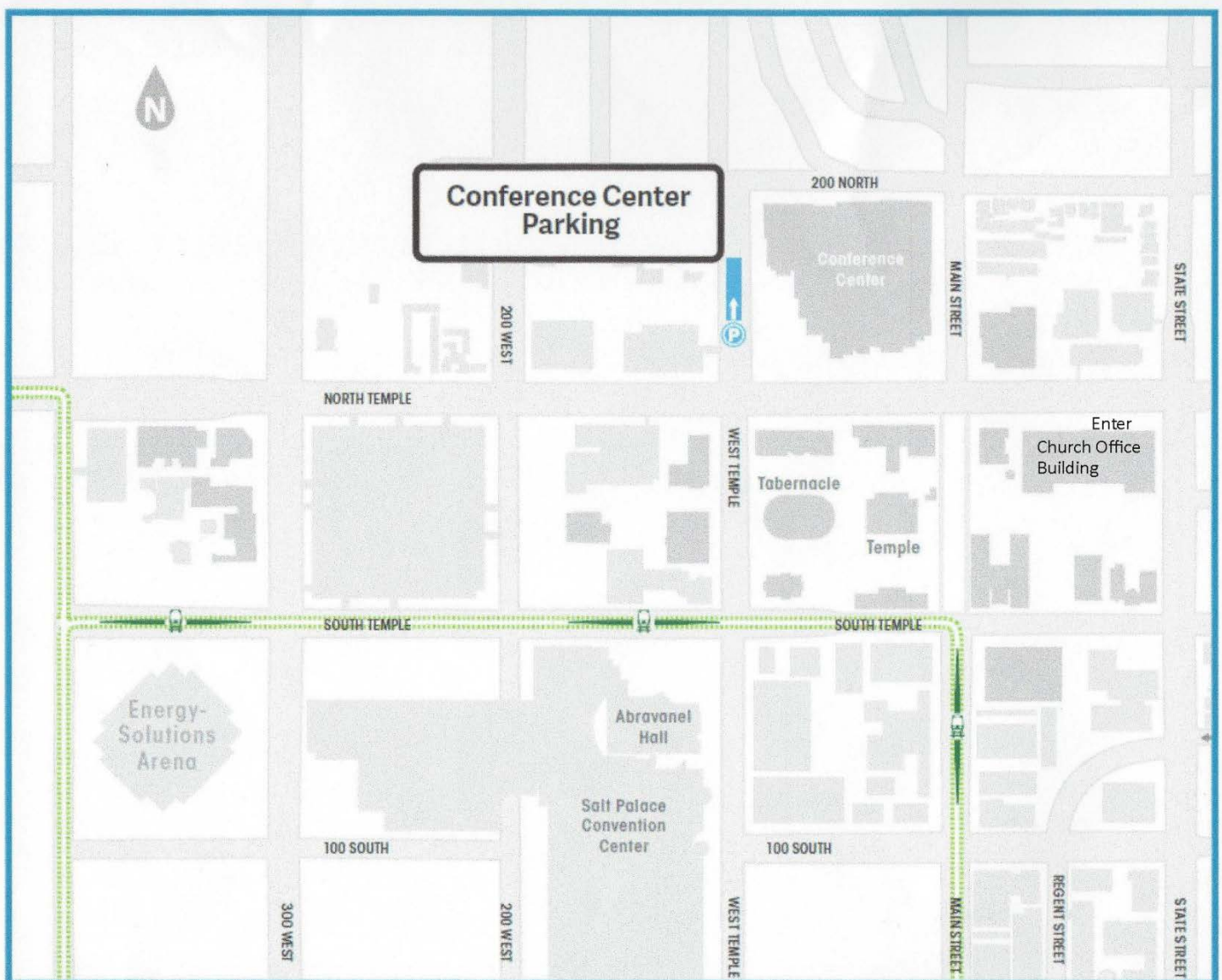


Reunion Fact Sheet:

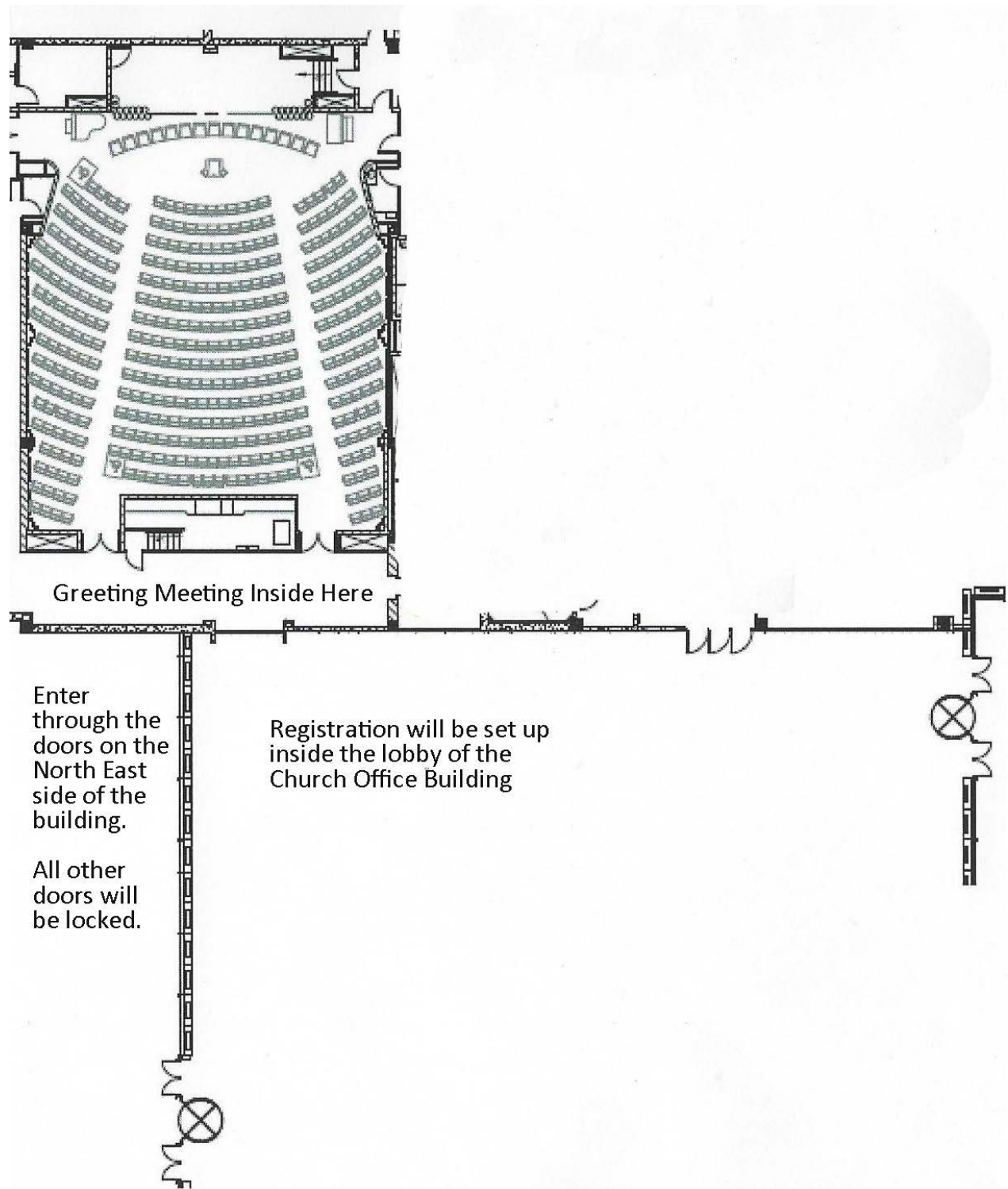


SUGGESTED PARKING FOR THIS VENUE

Map of registration area inside the Church Office Building



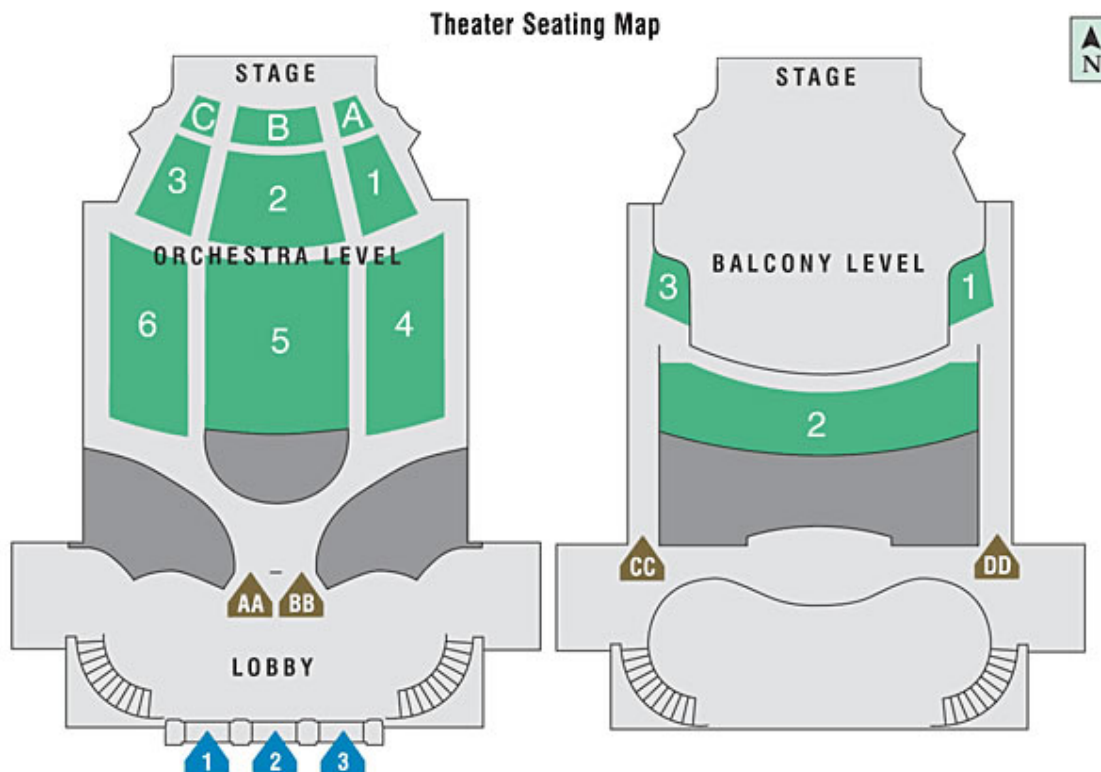
Friday, August 3

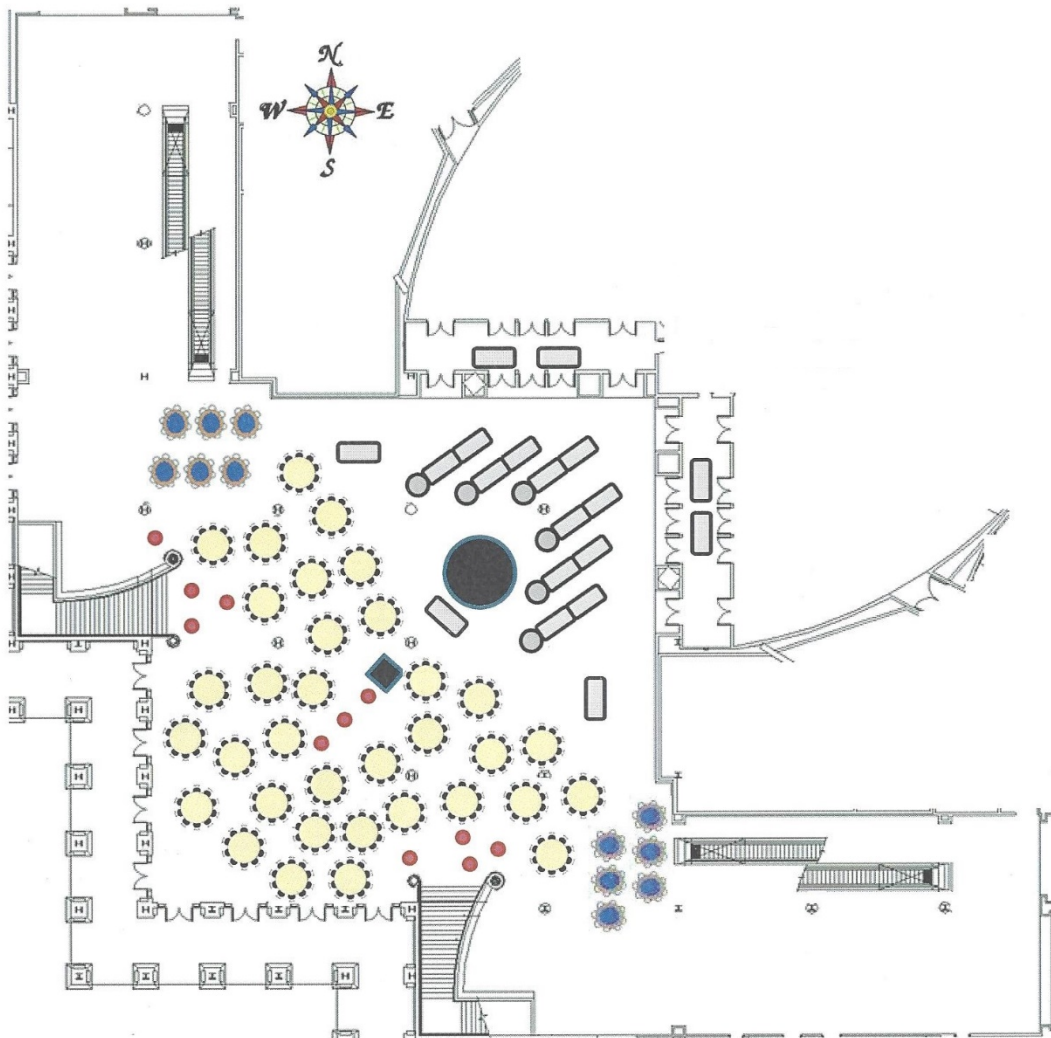


Friday Night Family Dinner

Map of This is the Place Heritage Park

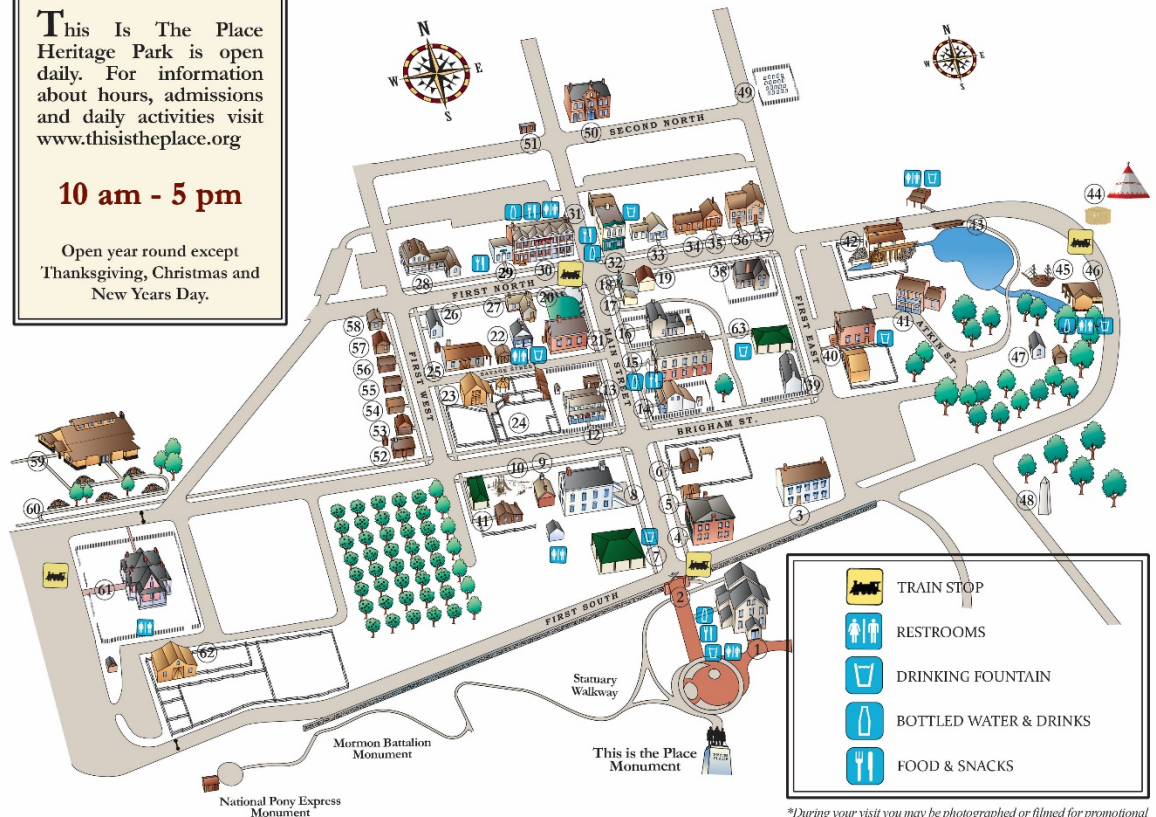

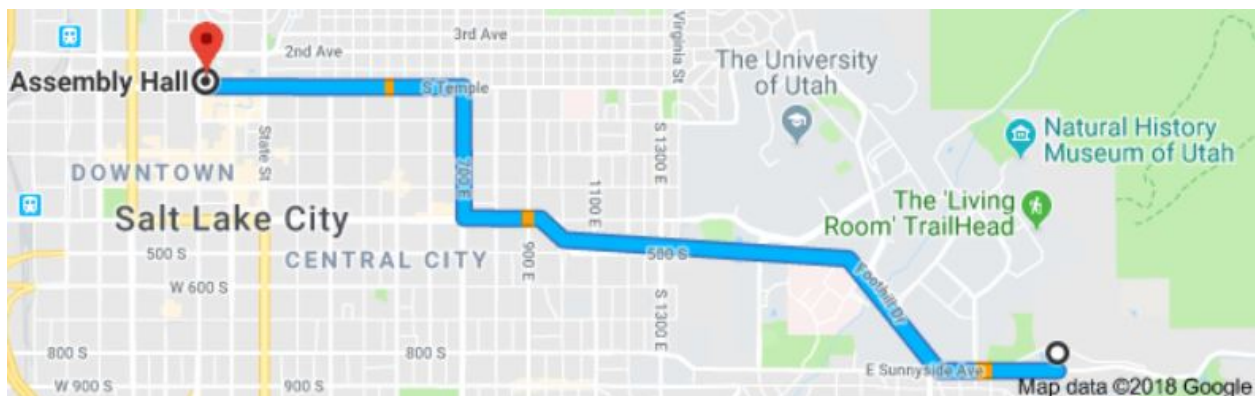
