"How many of you watched the Saratov Approach or Freetown? Quite a few of you. I have the director of those movie here with us. We are doing a partnering relationship with him to produce a movie that will be released in theaters about Liberty Jail. That director is with us today and I want to turn some time over to Garrett Batty."

Garrett said, "I am grateful for the opportunity to be here. I want to take a minute to tell you briefly about the movie that Mike and I are working on together. It is never too early to start spreading the word."

Garrett continued, "Our film is called Out of Liberty. I want to read a synopsis: In spring of 1839 a mob of armed men assembled outside the stone jailhouse located in Liberty, Missouri. Inside this small building six Mormon prisoners claiming their innocence against charges of high treason. Secretly plot one of numerous escape attempts to make sure that if the prisoners escape they will no doubt be met by the angry mobs. Should they risk waiting for a fair trial the mobs would continue their brutal actions toward the Mormon prisoners. Bridging the gap between these two groups stands one man, Samuel Tillery, the jailer tasked with keeping the two groups separate."


"For nearly four months the reluctant Tillery stands his post, keeping the Mormons locked in, and the mobs locked out. But his assignment is not without significant challenges. With the atrocious conditions of the jail, and the frequent ploys to escape, the prisoners push Tillery's patience, and fueling the jailer's mistrust of his captives is the incendiary public opinion towards the Mormons and the government's evolving response to the charges against them."

"Meanwhile, the prisoner's captivity attracts daily visitors, both friend and foe, including the controversial attorney, Alexander Donovan, and the eccentric Orin Porter Rockwell. Tillery's only hope is to outlast the conflict and keep peace until the trial in a property court."

"But when Donovan arranges a hearing to take place in a local barn, and a convincing plea from a deathly ill Sidney Rigdon, puts his prisoners' safety and conviction in doubt, Tillery begins to question his own role in the conflict."

"Does he continue to hold the prisoners, providing an easy target for the growing mob? Or does he aid in a government endorsed escape, risking retaliation from the opposition? One thing is for certain, the situation calls for immediate action, or Tillery's own life may be in danger."

"So, we are excited about this project. We start filming in October, so we're a little way out, but I'm thrilled to have this partnership take place. I've admired Michael's involvement with these other films and look forward to being able to share this with you early 2019. Thanks."
