

Join with fellow Smith descendants to visit sites where early historic events occurred and where monumental events are prophesied for the near future! The days are filled with Smith family connections and inspirational experiences never to be forgotten. You will return with a greater understanding of the immense value of the restored gospel and humbled at the price paid by your ancestors and their contemporaries to lay the foundation of a great work.

SUMMARY: Fly to Kansas City where a deluxe chartered bus takes you in comfort to family & church history sites in INDEPENDENCE, RICHMOND, LIBERTY, FAR WEST, ADAM-ONDI-AHMAN, QUINCY, NAUVOO, & CARTHAGE. Follow the IOWA MORMON TRAIL to GARDEN GROVE, MT PISGAH, and WINTER QUARTERS. The tour ends at Winter Quarters for a flight home from **Omaha**.

DAY 1 - Fly to Kansas City. Drive to Independence, the center of the future City of Zion and location of the Garden of Eden. Joseph Smith revealed many great historic & prophetic events for this area. Dinner & lodging nearby in Liberty MO

DAY 2 - Drive to Richmond to the graves of Oliver Cowdery & David Whitmer, hear their testimonies. Experience the Rebuking of the Guards narration of Parley P. Pratt talking of Joseph's "majesty in chains" as he called the profaning guards to silence. Enjoy an inspiring tour at Liberty Jail, Joseph's "temple prison" where he was held captive for 5 long wintry months. Share in a devotional at Far West, the last gathering place for the saints before the Missouri expulsion, where in spite of everything, it is still a dedicated temple site. Continue to **Adam-ondi-Ahman**, where Adam dwelt after the expulsion from the Garden of Eden; learn of this area's crucial role at the Savior's second coming. Lodging in Chillicothe MO.

DAY 3 – Drive west across Missouri to **Hannibal** to briefly see Mark Twain sites on the Mississippi River. Cross the river into Illinois then north to Quincy, the compassionate town that rescued 5,000 of our refugee saints when driven from Missouri in the bitter-cold winter of 1839. Continue north, stopping by the former Green Plains before passing through Warsaw on the way to beautiful Nauvoo. Evening Smith Reunion registration and Greeting Meeting. Lodging 3 nights in Nauvoo IL.

DAY 4 – Smith Reunion activities, service project, & family picnic lunch. Afternoon free time to visit Nauvoo's restored homes, shops, church buildings with missionary hosts. Our tour bus available for Nauvoo site "shuttle service" to tour members.

DAY 5 - Smith Reunion morning devotional at Carthage Jail and family photo. Return to Nauvoo for full day of free time to visit the Nauvoo sites. Evening reunion family dinner and gathering.

DAY 6 – Attend Sunday morning church services. Early afternoon departure to follow the Mormon Trail across lowa stopping at Garden Grove, third largest major pioneer trail settlement. Lodging in Osceola IA.

<u>DAY 7</u> – Continue following the Mormon Trail to **Mt Pisgah**, second largest settlement on the trail. View the same vistas many ancestors saw and a monument erected in their honor. Complete our trail journey with afternoon arrival in Kanesville and Winter Quarters **Trail Center**; get a feel for the magnitude of this largest settlement where pioneers camped in sod dugouts and built log cabins as they endured long winters before finishing their journey to the Salt Lake Valley. 600 unmarked pioneer graves. Beautiful sculptures. Remarkable Winter Quarters Temple grounds visit to cap off the week! Fly home this evening from Omaha returning with renewed faith and determination to carry on your Mormon Heritage.
