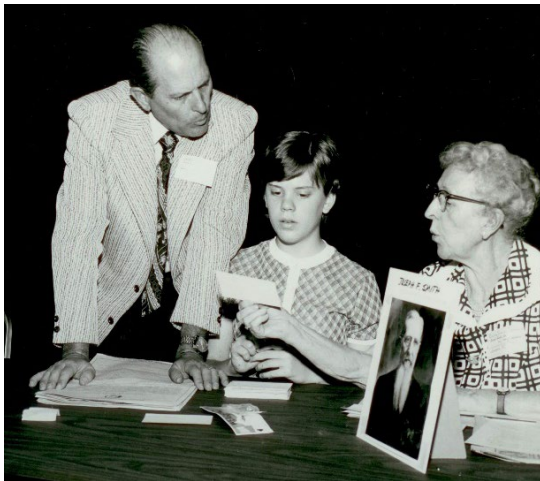
Buddy Youngreen commissioned artist, William Whitaker to create an image of each of the Smith Family members. Many displays used those images and helped everyone identify the line they came through.

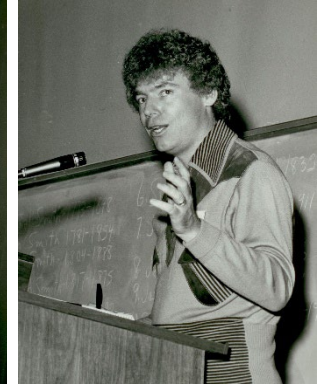

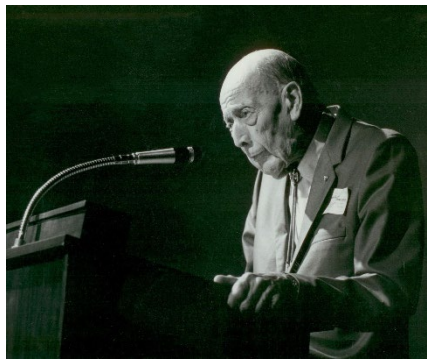
