 Built in the year 1799.*

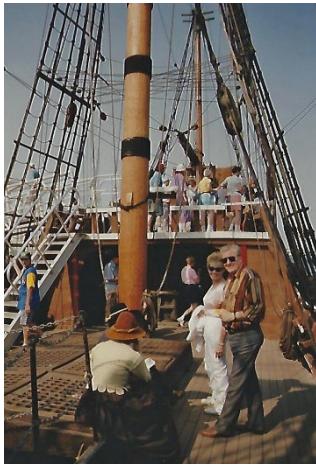
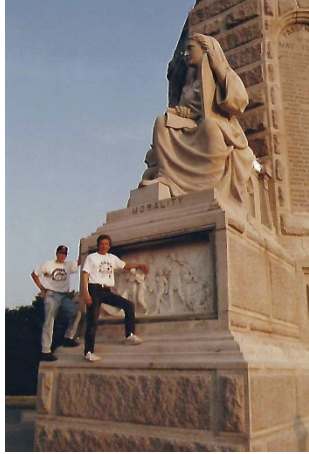




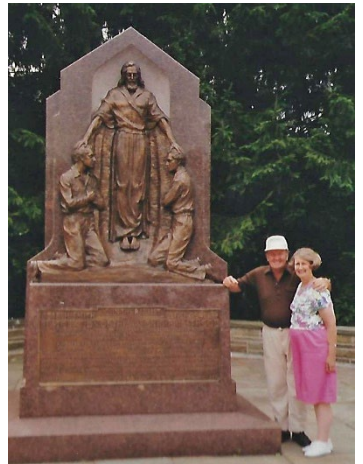


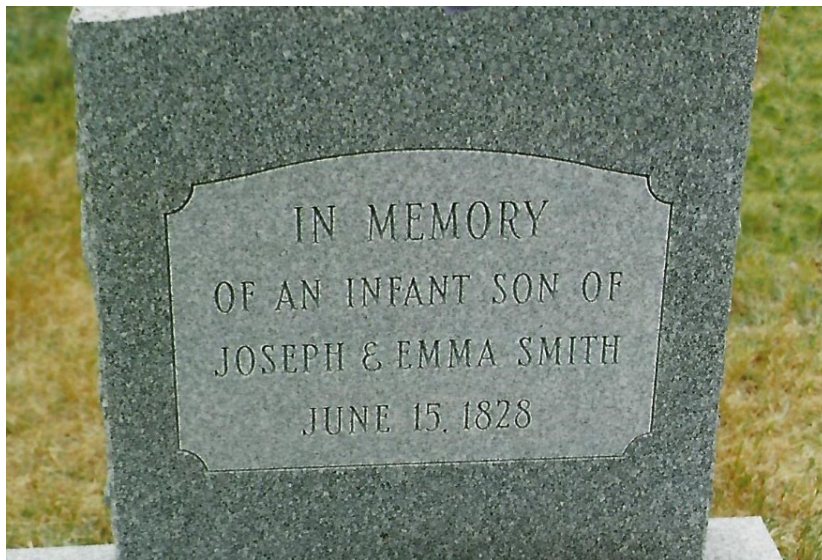




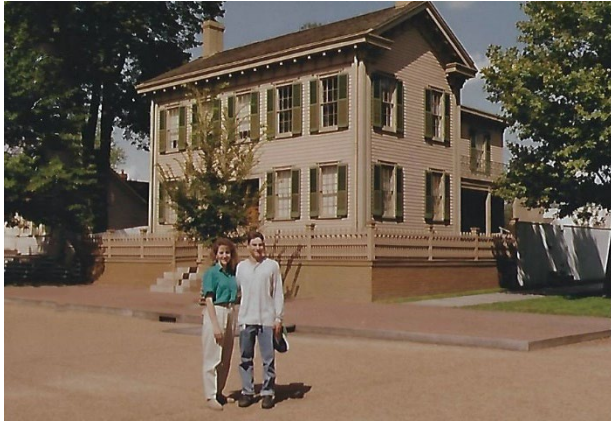

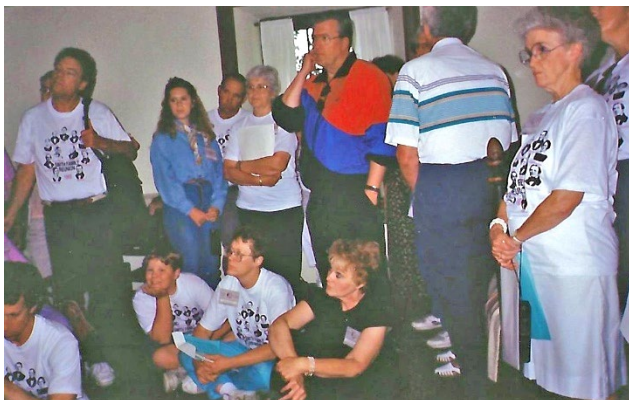
