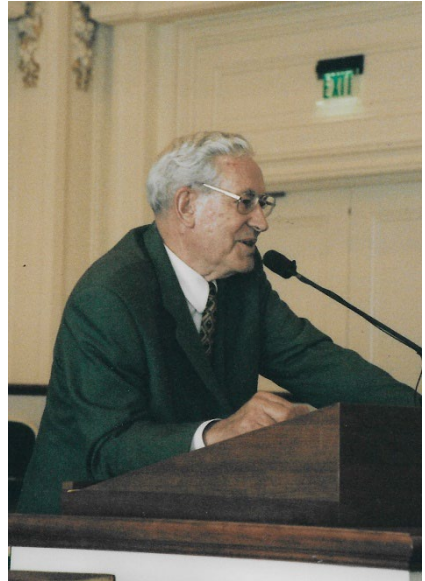

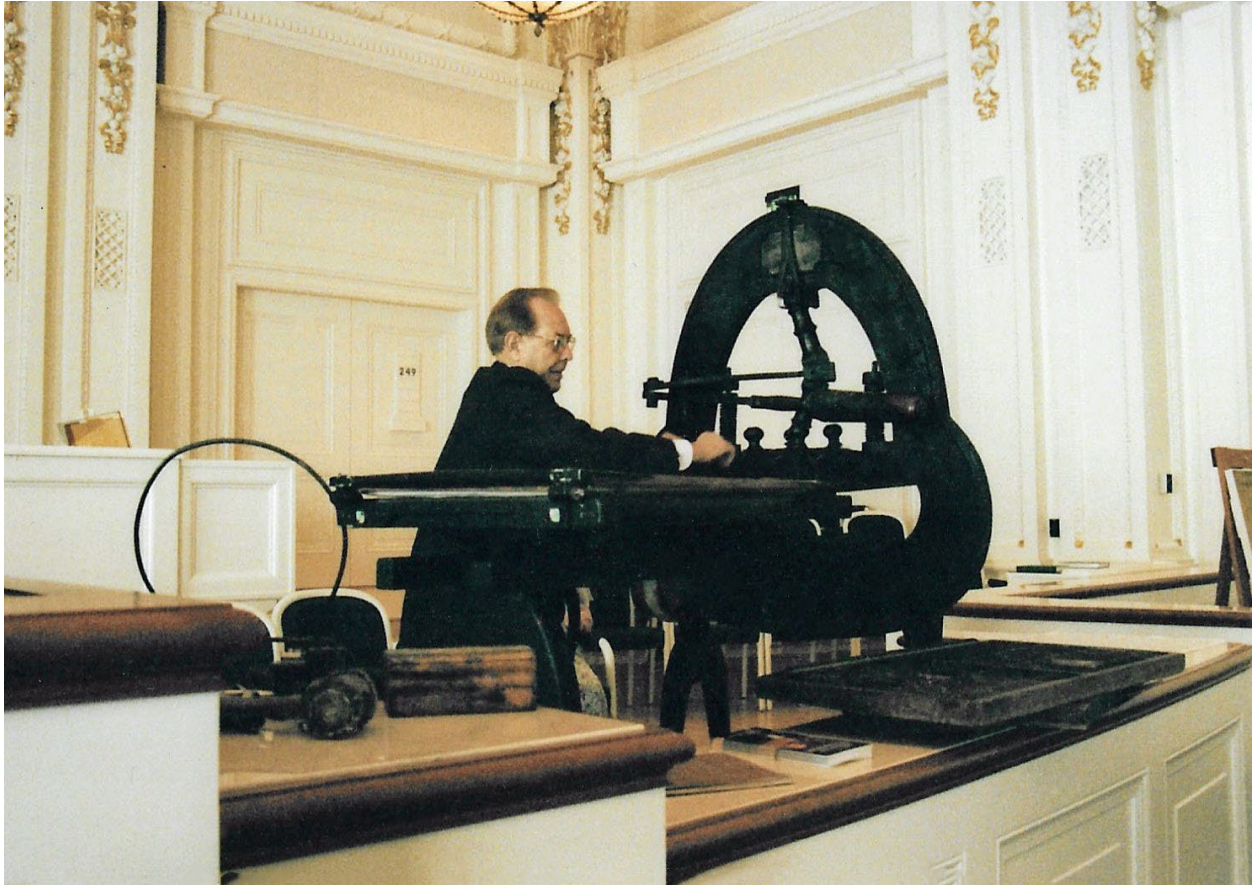

Her oppressions weigh'd him down.

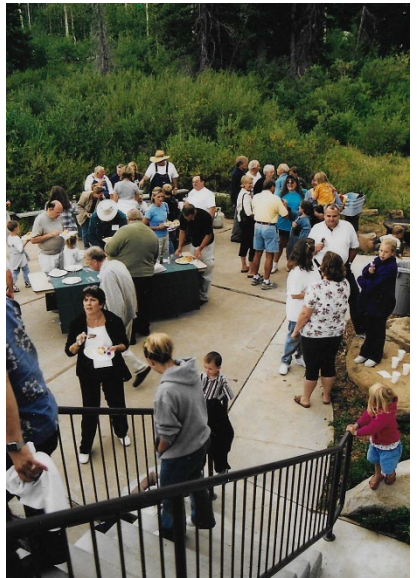
Now he's gone; We'd not recall him

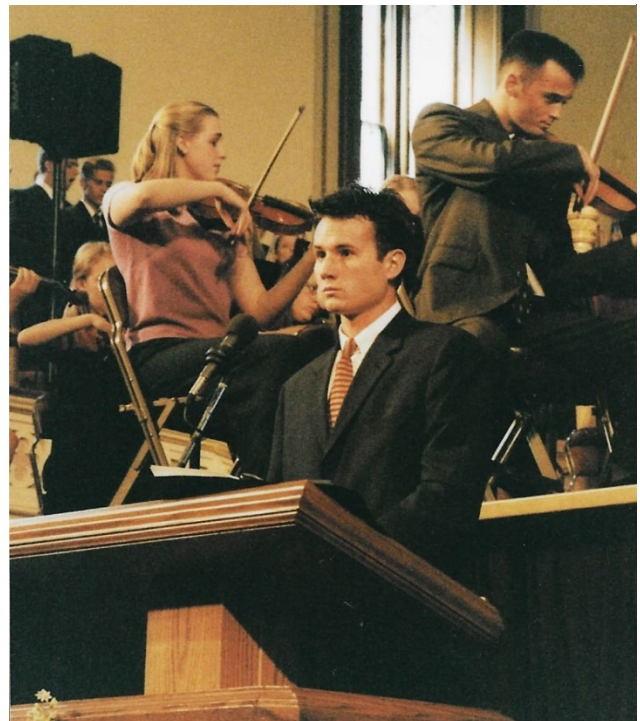

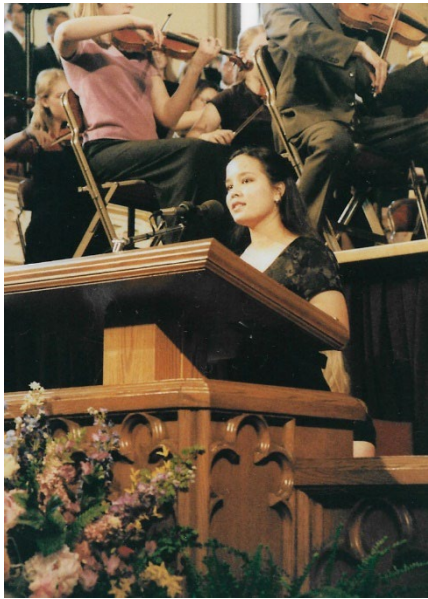
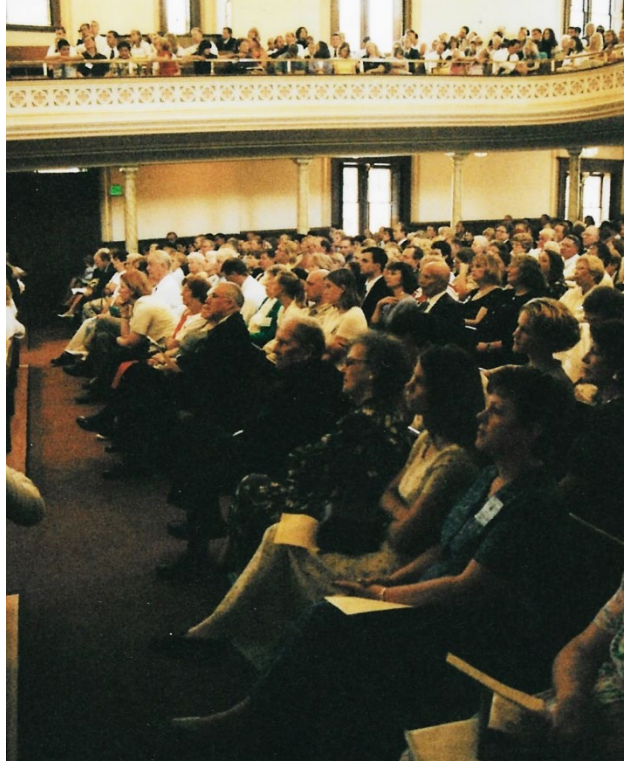
