## Smith relatives buried in Rose Hill Cemetery in Lamoni, Iowa

There were Smith family living in Lamoni from 1880 through 1930s. This was the headquarters for the RLDS Church for many years. They had a printing office, steam press and bindery even after the church moved headquarters to Independence in 1906. They had many conferences in Lamoni and also at places like Far West where the little white RLDS Chapel stands across from the Far West Temple site. There is a little place four miles south of the Iowa/Missouri border where the RLDS had a church building and held many early conferences there. Alexander and Elizabeth's farm was just a short distance south of that church.
